

GSC 2020 | General Body Meeting

November 17th, 2020

Discussed items:

- The charter has been delivered to the graduate affairs and is still pending approval.
- For divisional council, Sarah and other GSC members met with CEMSE potential students and identified a president. For BESE, an alternative president is still needed for next semester. All three divisional councils will be set to function properly in the Spring of 2021.
- Terms of reference for the new role CSOO has also been delivered to the graduate affairs and is still pending approval.
- Launching a GSC newsletter will be an effective approach to increase GSC's transparency and the student body's engagement. It is necessary to be regular. The GSC newsletter could be aligned with the University Student Leaders Forum, which will hopefully be launched at the beginning of 2021. This forum should occur ideally every two months at least to foster collaboration between different student organizations.
- Mram discussed that the delay of chemicals causes a significant change to the quality when the internal pressures finish weeks before delivery. She proposed to shorten the approval process by eliminating unnecessary or redundant steps. Sarah is going to work with Mram on resolving this issue.
- The social media competition is canceled because of logistics and the saturation of the number of competitions around campus. The GSC achievement post will be shared on social media and the graduate bulletin this week.
- Michael is proposing a spot for GSC to speak during the commencement, which will empower the student body as a whole.
