Discussed items:

- Ammar started by updating the members on the KC3 Education Domain outcomes. KAUST is aiming to accommodate the onboarding process with hybrid classes to maintain sponsorship. KAUST will start with Saudi students due to the logistics with the current COVID19 situation.
- Ammar sent an email and encouraged suggestions on the faculty & students' hybrid course workshop.
